

A GLIMPSE OF THE ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Out of the 81 students appeared in class X, 27 secured 90 above and Naveena Claire Aji emerged the school topper by securing 97%. Out of 45 students appeared, 2 students attained Full A1, 25 scored distinction and all the others bagged first class. Devika Suresh (Science Stream) and Anna Therese George (Commerce Stream) emerged as the school toppers by securing 96 % and 85%.

STUDENTS' ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME

To ensure that our students are equipped to face any challenge, we have focussed on a few student enrichment programme. By providing a conductive and encouraging environment the students are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and inter school activities and competitions. It enables the student to grow in confidence, knowledge and enhance their all round development.

A career orientation for class XI and XII students were conducted by ICAT in the month of October 2019. Ms Smitha was the resource person.

A career guidance and counselling program was conducted for the students of class IX and X in the month of November 2019.

To commemorate the Gandhi Jayanthi, a workshop was organized by social science teachers for class IX students on October 3rd 2019. Ms Elsamma Mathew and Ms. Jeffy M Tom introduced to students how to make a cloth and paper carry bags. Students made the carry bags and paper bags and distributed them to nearby shops and houses. Students went around the campus for cleaning and they were planting saplings and tried to beautify the campus.



To commemorate the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi a unique exhibition is being organized by Alphonsa College Pala on 14th October 2019. Our students of classes VIII, IX and X participated in the exhibition and the quiz competition and Kumari Ann Treesa Jijo secured the first prize.

School arranged a planetarium show for all the students of Carmel Public school on 7th &16th of august 2019. It was the replica of the theatre devoted to popular education and entertainment in astronomy and related fields, especially space science and traditionally constructed with a hemispheric

- ❖ The Central Board of Education has fixed our school as the Examination Centre of CBSE Board examinations class X and XII conducted in the months of February, March and April 2019. We have placed all the arrangements at the disposal of the board for the conduct of the examinations. We have fulfilled all the conditions and criteria for the same.

Inspection

This year we had the inspection from CBSE board for the extension of the CBSE affiliation. The inspection team comprised of the principals of the leading schools Mrs. Nirmala Venketeswaran of Bhavans Vidya Mandir and Mrs. Elizebath Mani from Christhava Mahilalayam, Thottumugham, Aluva. Mrs. Elizabeth Mani and her team came for checking the various aspects ranging from land of the school to teaching methodology and boundary walls and the availability of all the basic infra-structure and amenities. During the inspection the team took the videos right from its entrance, classrooms, labs, activity rooms, class room teachings, scrutinizing the documents till the time she leaves the school. Everything is recorded and is then sent to CBSE. There was a staff meeting and Mrs. Elizabeth Mani congratulated the management, Principal and staff for their efforts taken and gave various suggestions to the teachers regarding academics as well as cocurricular activities. She was very much convinced with the functioning of Carmel Public school. I am very happy to announce that we met all the requirements needed and received an excellent feedback from the inspection team.
