## A GLIMPSE OF THE ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ✓ *Communicative English Leaders (CEL) were chosen and given badges.*

- ✓ *Speaking tests for individual students were conducted on a regular basis.*
- ✓ *CE Counseling is a way to get to know the children personally and understand what inhibits them from speaking out in English in the classroom environment*
- ✓ *Merit Card – Whenever any student does something good / positive, wins a game or performs a tasks, they can claim a Merit Card. At the end of the term the one who gets most Merit Cards will be given prizes.*

- ✓ Virtual interactive classroom *These are communicative English sessions in which students sitting in a particular classroom interact with students in another classroom virtually. This is an innovative approach seeking to explore the possibilities of online interaction in learning English in real-life situations. A few interactive sessions of this kind were held this year and students could exchange ideas, ask questions and elicit answers. It is sure that these virtual interactions will really enhance students' listening and speaking skills.*
